



BAFA Return to Play Road Map - Scotland Stage 4

Levels 0-4 overview (With effect from 12 March 2021)

The Scottish Government has moved to a strategic approach to manage Covid-19 based on five graduated levels of protection. American football activity in Scotland is currently at Stage 4 in BAFA's Return to Play Roadmap. Below is a table showing what this means for each protection level.
